As you can see from the accounts you have that they are set out differently this year under taken by Mr Steven Clarke ACMA. This is so that you can see items being individually itemised so you get a better picture of how the club funds are used, from booking venues to donations to the rescue.

I spent two days just sorting out 18 years of paper work to find invoices for stock that had been brought in previous years. This was a job that needed doing! because, I needed to find the purchase price of the stock so I could see what profit (if any) the club was making. ANNUAL HEALTH REPORT 2015

There is very little to report on this year. It is a very long time since any member spoke to me about any health concerns in the breed and I have chosen to take this as a good indicator of the overall health of the Schipperke.

MPSIIB I continue to be disappointed and frustrated by Dr Giger's repeated failure, over a number of years now, to fulfil his promises to publish the material which resulted in the test for this degenerative condition. I had quite an active correspondence with him in 2016 since I had read that his facility had produced another test for a condition found in Miniature Schnauzers and that this had also not been peer reviewed. I received further assurances that publication was imminent but have had no further information in recent months. I continue to pursue him.

A few months ago, the Health Committee was made aware of a possible new test for MPSIIB which could be offered by a research facility in Cambridge. Some details were made available and with a financial contribution from the Schipperke Club, further work could have been undertaken to develop a test. Unlike the situation 8 or 10 years ago when I explored this option with the Animal Health Trust, developing a new test would not now be quite such a lengthy and laborious process as it was then, given scientific advancements. After careful consideration, the Health Committee concluded that there was little reason to abandon the current US test which has been consistent and reliable over years now, in favour of a test which has yet to be established, would need to be piloted and was likely only to be deemed reliable by breeders after two or three generations had been bred. Such a process would take three or four years at the very least.

It would be immensely helpful, therefore, if ALL breeders made FULL use of the TEST RESULT REGISTERS on the Club web-site, especially to register those puppies which are CLEAR BY DESCENT. There is a developing picture of a disease which we have now got under control. Only 5 tested CARRIERS have been registered in the last 3 years, for example. To help ensure that overall picture is indeed correct, however, your ASSISTANCE IS NEEDED.

HELSINKI EPILEPSY STUDY No recent update but the work is ongoing. Contributions from breeders in this country have been DISAPPOINTING but swabs can still be submitted.

BREED HEALTH CONSERVATION PLANS The KC launched this new initiative recently and in due course we will be asked to produce a breed plan which I anticipate will be based largely on our annual health reports over the years.

In June 2016 I had a call I expected from at some point from Gordon's daughter. Gordon had died and was found in the hallway on the floor with Sam by his side.

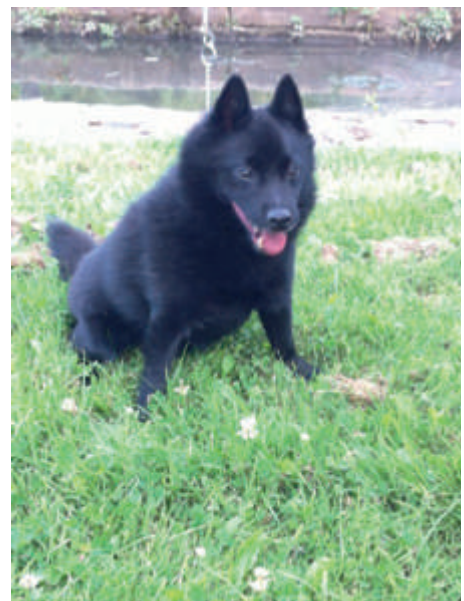
I went to get Sam and brought him back to the kennels. He was more settled this time and some would say that he had closure having seen Gordon.

With the help of Lesley and Andy Cheatham a home check was done and I let Sam go to his new forever home. I understand he is loved and pampered living a very privileged life. He is very happy but this is one little rescue I really miss.

The Schipperke Club Ch Show 15/10/16

Thank you to the Club for the honour of judging the Ch Sh & their hospitality, and to my two stewards who apart from their hard work, also kept me amused throughout the day.

Generally, heads were very good but I had some concerns that a fair number of exhibits were missing the true 'cobby' shape of this delightful breed, because once I moved beyond the head, neck and shoulders, it was a gamble as to what would lie beyond that point. There were a few with relatively weak hindquarters and/or with limited angulation. Please do not go down the route of making heads the be all and end all. The standard calls for a strong loin and it was surprising to me some were very long and weak in that area too.

Coat and cleanliness were a delight, as were small cat-life feet with beautifully short nails and a major issue for me that when judging the breeds I do, how often dental hygiene is not given the priority it should receive, but in your breed, it was an absolute pleasure, in even the very senior exhibits, to find lovely gleaming white teeth, and to such a point that they can compete with much younger exhibits on the same level. This is a real credit to you all.

One handling issue I feel I cannot let go without remark. I appreciate that as a free-standing breed in the main, and that bait is used to gain attention, but the whole point is that the bait should be used in the stand position and as a reward for something done well. Quite a common mistake was that I had dogs coming toward me with their heads tilted up towards the handler. This is not a natural position for any dog if it is to move freely, and what it ends doing is put the centre of balance off kilter, and therefore as the dog is approaching the judge, the front swing from side to side and it was so bad it was still evident even when the dog was going away, I could still see the front legs going out sideways and it really spoils the movement all together. There are plenty of mobile devices you can use for yourself to see this problem if you think it applies to your dog.

MPD 2 Entered

1st Mance's Ryman Robin

Neat and tidy throughout, has a pleasing head with a good width to it for one so young. His ears are nicely set, and he possesses bright inquisitive eyes. Neck is of a desirable length, shoulders satisfactory, good straight front and stands on very tidy feet, back is short, holds his topline well, good depth to his chest and has a strong loin. Felt his tail placement could have been better set and carried. All he needs now is further muscle development and I am sure he will have a very bright future.

2nd Massey's Ristine Tweedledee

Possesses a pleasing skull and with a decent width to it for one so young, nice ear set however doesn't always use them when stood, tends to carry then much better on the move and he needs a little more development to the muzzle width and to fill under the eyes to finish what I think will be nice picture when he is older. Good forequarters, tidy from and neat feet. Ribbing is OK for his age loin needs to strengthen. When he concentrates, he moves well but is easily distracted by what he thinks is laying on the floor a lot of the time. I think he will be slow to develop, but it will be worth waiting for.

He possesses a nicely made head which is well developed for his age, and has that true bright and inquisitive expression which is one of the trademarks of the breed. Shoulders are nicely made but needs further muscle development across them to give a better picture when he is coming towards. Carries reasonable body throughout but it does need to firm up more. Good, strong short loin, and rear action is tidier than the front one. All in all just needs time to finish and I feel he should have a good future.

2nd Ristine Tweedledee

JD 1 Entered

1st Holmes' Aradet Captain Jack by Dencas

Quite mature despite him only being 9 months old. Pleasing head but needs a shade more filling out under the eyes, good strong neck flowing into a very decent pair of shoulders and good straight front legs and stands on lovely neat feet of the correct shape. He has a good topline which was better on the move than it was on the table, firm with a strong loin and well-made rear quarters. Movement erratic at times, he can demonstrate it is so inclined but decided to mess around in the BPIS challenge.

Sp Yr D 2 Entered

1st Massey's Ristine Jack Black

Litter brother to the 2nd but they gave me a bit of a headache as they are developing at different rates in different areas. I preferred this one as I felt he has the better head & overall balance at the moment. He carries his ears well, he has a bright and inquisitive expression, need a shade more development to the depth of the chest. Topline is strong and has a consistent tidy movement fore and aft.

2nd Smith's Ristine Black Sabbath

I felt this one is at a more in-between stage than his brother; what is there is good but overall he needs to mature and firm up in body, better muscled at rear than he is at the front so therefore not so consistent on the move. I am sure that when he catches up, these two will be strong completion for one another; both just need time to mature.

PG D 3 Entered - 1 Absent

1st Jones' Roopec Sinky Demon

Smart cobby dog, which possesses a decent head, a good firm topline & nice strong loin. Very pleasing depth of chest, with a good spring to the ribs. He has good muscle to the neck, running down into a decent pair of shoulders, however he is too bait orientated and when coming towards he is looking up to the handler and in the process his front swings. Rear action was far more consistent. He far better when going around the ring as he is not looking for the bait so much. He is not the largest of males but still remains masculine, stands well on the floor and the table.

2nd Huyton's Catchwell Do The Dark

Stood he looked like my winner, he is mature and carries decent body and muscle but he throws away his advantage on the move because he is far too interested in bait and coming towards swings in front alarmingly and also does this on the go around. If the habit was broken he would present a far better picture. Has a very nice head piece on him, lovely set to the ears bright inquisitive eyes which are of the correct shape and good muzzle but dentition could be better. Strong well-muscled neck, good shoulders and firm topline.

LD 7 Entered

1st Whales' Aradet Ballroom Dancer at Roshaana

Little doubt in my mind that this one is going to be one of the stars of the future because he has all the right attributes in all the right places and all he needs to do now is mature and firm up in the muscle. I loved his head and the fore and aft on the move, very tidy and typical short and brisk in his stride. He gets a shade distracted at times but that is because he is so alert as to what is going on around him but most of all his firm topline and strong short loin gave him a lovely profile so often lacking in other exhibits.

2nd Mance's Mywulf Blue Sapphire

This was another that I liked very much. Not quite as well developed in the head than the winner but he has a good strong neck, good pair of shoulders, firm topline, good short loin and nicely made rear. I thought he was a shade weak on the front pasters but I feel as he muscled up more it is possible to correct this.

3rd Moore & Noch's Chadbower Finlay for Blitzstan

Neat cobby dog which tends to get a bit carried away on the move, moves much better when he slows down a shade. He pleases in head but would prefer a deeper pigment on the nose, ears well set. Bright inquisitive eyes.

OD 6 Entered - 2 Absent

1st Philpott's Ch Aradet Expert Timing

He had the most overall balance of all the dogs I judged today, the symmetry of the outline stood him apart from his fellow exhibits. Well balanced head of correct proportions on top of a strong neck and flowed into good shoulders, nice straight front legs. Topline sound and firm good strong loin well-muscled rear and moved as the standard requires. Handler need to be aware of how this dog sets himself at times, as he tends to overstretch himself making him look longer than he actually is. He is cobby and judges need to see that. Happy to award him the DCC and BIS.

2nd Fludder's Aradet Xtra Addition

Litter brother to the winner and shares many of his attributes but for me he does need to firm up in the body and have better muscle tone. Slightly smaller frame than the 1st but still masculine, has a strong loin and in good jacket. Moves foot perfect and stands exactly how he should do. Pushed hard for the RCC.

3rd Donaldson's Aradet Zulo Von Zorbaloo

Neat and tidy dog all round, pleases in the head, but does not always make best use of his ears. Pleasant expression, good shape to the eye, nicely muscled throughout, strong loin and correct movement.

AOC OD 1 Entered

1st **Chadbower Finlay for Blitzstan**

Vet D Under 10yrs 1 Entered

1st Fludder's Aradet Shot In The Dark

On first sight, he seems a little portly, but he isn't, he just happens to have a great wealth of coat and his muscle quality and body are correctly proportioned. Pleases in the head, has a nice expression with bright and alert eyes. Good neck which runs down into well placed shoulders, and has a corresponding rear which compliments him in balance. His topline is far better on the floor than it was on the table. Front movement very sound, rear is just beginning to show signs of his age, but this doesn't stop him showing his heart out.

A lovely class and all are a credit to their owners as condition and looks believ their respective ages.

1st Mance's Ch Schipdale Orlando

A dog who has done very well under me over the years and my opinion of him has not changed in all that time. I think there is little I have left to say about him, he is still top quality and he knows it, but today I felt he had to give way to a younger pretender, but was still happy to award him the RDCC.

2nd Wilson's Ch Aradet Off The Chart at Lyncathmor

He very obviously has no idea about how old he is at 12½ because he showed as if his age had been measured in months rather than years. Of good make and shape and has the desired cobby shape which was missing in a good number of exhibits today. Very sound on the move with the typical movement expected of the breed.

3rd Manners' Komargo's Crazy Diamond at Roopec

Just a shade out of jacket compared to the others but it does show off his good overall shape and balance. Good angles fore and aft but especially at the rear which a few times today I thought was missing in some other classes. Very happy little man who was delighted to be given the chance to show what he can do on the move.

2nd Leah Scales

Leah is a calm and confident handler who was also at one with her dog here, tidy foot work and presented her dog well at all times and only made one minor error which cost her the class win, so close was the competition.

1st Leaf's Skipon Golden Gemma

Very feminine, and neat and tidy all round, presents a lovely outline. Pretty, well-constructed head with nice shape and carriage to the ears. More mature in development than her class mate. She moves exactly as she is meant to and showed herself off at all time, and has the bright and alert expression one expects of this breed. BPB and BPIS.

2nd Deat's Aradet Cygneture Tune

Quite a raw baby who was not always fully confident and therefore does not give of her best. I felt she was of a good make and shape once she settled. She had flashes of knowing and understanding what is required of her but then has a moment of doubt and draws in on herself. When she wants to move, she can, and demonstrates how well she is constructed. I think once she gets her head around the concept of the show world she will have a lot to contribute to it.

PB 3 Entered - 1 Absent

1st Reed-Peck's Deakie Philamena Byquy

Very neat and tidy bitch still quite raw in some respects but I was minded that everything was in the right place and it was just a matter time and development which would take her forward to a bright future. I lean towards the idea she will be a slow developer but the quality is there nonetheless and she had to take the class on that basis,

2nd Fegan's Wagaman Black Raven

Similar comments apply here as they do to the winner but she had the odd lapse of concentration and loses whatever advantage she has gained previously. However, she is well constructed.

3rd Wearing's Aradet Xotic Dancer

A shade at that in-between stage both in coat and body, but nonetheless has a great deal of potential. She possesses a nice head, lovely eye and expression and when she want to she can move well.

LB 6 Entered - 3 Absent

1st Fellow's Nocte Amerina at Blackshuck

I understand this one was not with her usual handler and therefore not as confident as she might be, but if the current handler was to gain more confidence in his abilities, I think she would troubling others for top honours. She has a lovely head and ear set, super muscle tone and body and the firmest of topline both standing and moving. She can move with purpose and demonstrate the correct gait with ease. I hope this pairing gel better in the future as I am sure she can have a bright future.

2nd Donaldson's Zorbaloo Concrete Blonde

Generally a very pleasing head and body with good balance all round. Excelled in the movement department in fact there were times when she needed to be reined in a bit as she is so eager to show herself off. Has the brightest expression one could ask for, misses nothing at all, firm topline and good angles fore and aft.

3rd Massey's Scipsar Alice In Wonderland at Ristine

Nothing to dislike about this one, generally of good make and shape but did tend to widen at the rear when going away, more because she was leaning into her collar in her eagerness. Presented a better side gait.

OB 7 Entered - 1 Absent

1st Fludder's Am Ch Ebornorth Never On A Sunday

Loud and proud and knows, it very much the showgirl and has to ability to turn it on when she needs to. Nothing much I would change about her other than I feel that she needs to firm up in the body a shade. Has a cracking pair of shoulders, and a strong neck and a very good topline. Where she really sets he self apart is on the move, foot perfect every time. CC & RBIS.

2nd Fegan's Wagaman Black Magic

Nothing about this one I would want to change other than to ask her to settle more on the move as she is so enthusiastic. She has a good head with correct ear set pleasing in the topline, and when she moves correctly, it is a pleasure to watch. She has the correct muscle in all the right places and with a super coat to top it off. Sets herself perfectly when stood and shows herself to her best advantage.

3rd Hart & Hawkins' Ch Carossa Last Orders

I really did like this one a lot, but today her mind appeared to be on anything other than the job in hand. She was a complete and utter fidget and I just think another day, another show, in a different frame of mind, she would have gained the CC. She is deservedly a Ch as she is full of quality.

1st Zorbaloo Concrete Blonde

Vet B Under 10yrs 1 Entered

1st Robjohns' Qwontox Quintessential ShCm

Carrying a little bit of middle age spread, especially over the shoulders which makes her from a little wider than desired, but other than that she presented a good picture of herself and has a good overall balance.

Vet B Over 10yrs 4 Entered - 1 Absent

1st Whales' Ch Qwontox Quidnunc by Roshaana

Another one I have done well over the years. She is a good honest type, nothing about her over done or overstated. She has a lovely balance and pleased me all departments. Her condition and attitude belies her age and she was presented in lovely condition RBCC.

2nd Wearing's Aradet Party Politics

Nice older lady of good make and shape, she certainly has the cobby appearance required. She enjoys herself in the ring, movement very sound for one of her age, and gives a good account of herself.

3rd Robjohns' Qwontox Celtic Quest ShCM

A shade matronly but given her 12½ years it is forgivable. Other than that, and a slight weakness in the pasterns, she gave a very good account of herself and certainly demands that she is given attention she feels she demands.

She had a tendency to wrap herself around her handler which almost cost her but upon joining the line she got her act together to move with drive and purpose.

2nd Massey's – RISTINE JACK BLACK – 20 month black male. I feel he needs a little more time to mature to catch up with his litter brother but I preferred his eye to his brother(3rd). He moved very true though not as brisque as 1st when in silhouette.

3rd Smith's – RISTINE BLACK SABBETH – 20 month litter brother to 2nd slightly more mature than his brother and nicely constructed I was splitting hairs with all three but when on the move he had a tendency to pin in a fraction on the rear and his handler caught him a few times causing his front to unbalance therefore swinging out on the front movement.

LIMIT

1ST Whale's – ARADET BALLROOM DANCER AT ROSHANNA JW – 20 month black male. Not at his happiest on the table like most before him he was finding it difficult to keep his feet. There is no mistaking his gender. Flat skull slight stop and a lovely oval eye that has the mischief ready to explode twinkle. Good scissor bite and strong under jaw. Strong neck with well defined mane set on shoulders of good proportions and angles. Well sprung ribs strong loin and high tail set. As soon as his feet touched the ground he was ready to go. Rear pasterns parallel propelled him forward away from me with good parallel front legs toward me. From the side he was brisk keeping a good strong top line

2ND Donaldson's – ZORBALOO CONCRETE BLONDE – As her name suggests she is a beautiful blonde bombshell. Lovely pigmentation for a cream around eye and on nose. She is well constructed and moved like a steam train powerful and true keeping a good topline. When she stood in line she demanded attention which i felt she lost later in the day for some reason.

3RD Jone's – ROOPEC DINKY DEMON - Nice compact black male of almost 4 yrs with a 3 digit tail. He is well constructed with a level topline but when on the move tended to turn his head to look at his handler which caused him to pin in on a rear pastern .

OPEN

1ST Donaldson's – Ch. ZORBALOO THE BLACK ICE – I think i have fallen in love she has a very cheeky mischievous expression. What you see is what get with her very feminine but strong and compact. Lovely head with oval eye. Strong neck on very good shoulders with well sprung ribs compact strong loin and good tuck up. Nice angulations fore and aft . Although she is out of coat the coat definitions were very clear. Moved with power and determination keeping a level top line at all times .

2nd Fegan's – WAGAMAN BLACK MAGIC- So unfortunate to meet 1st these two bitches were very alike in many ways and was splitting hairs between them. It took just a turn of the head when moving and a slightly longer stance to split them

3rd Fludder's – ARADET XTRA ADDITION – 5 year old black male. There is so much to like about him from his head and expression to his wonderful construction and determined movement. If anything i would like a fraction more of him but he showed like a true professional.

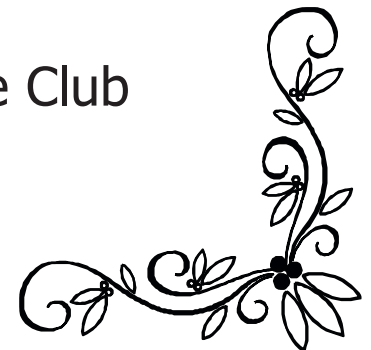

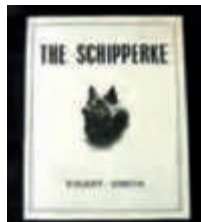

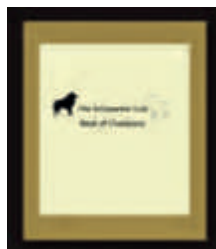
