# The Schipperke Club Open Show 26th March 2017

Firstly I would like to thank the Committee and Members for inviting me to judge your annual open show . The show was played out in a truly friendly atmosphere and all the prize winners were generously applauded after each class. The breed appears to be in a good position as I found the entry generally to be very typy. All the exhibits were presented in a very clean and tidy condition and temperaments were excellent. I was more than pleased with my winners and headpieces in the main were very consistent. There were a few exhibits which did not quite display the essential true cobby shape and this in turn reveals a longer and weaker loin rather than the strong short loin called for in the standard. My thanks go to my very efficient stewards, Mary and Penny.

1. **Bugg's Komargo Frankie Falsetto.** Well constructed with a pleasing head and bright and dark eye . Nicely angled shoulders and well ribbed, His loin will strengthen and he should have a good future. BPD
2. **Reed-Peck's Komargo Freddie Flintoff at Byquy.** I see these are litter brothers and my same comments apply. Well put together with a good headpiece. Very nice shape in profile. He was just a little untidy today coming on.

1. **Mance's Ryeman Robin.** This young male was in lovely coat . He has typical features , a strong neck and straight topline. Nice depth to brisket and strong loin. Moved out with a positive drive.
2. **Brooks & Davis' Deakie Donnedinnie.** A little taller than 1 but has a good profile. Typical headpiece on a good neck,deep brisket and nice stifle. Lively type and proving quite a handful for his handler.
3. **Massey's Ristine Tweedledee.** Has a pleasing head shape and eye. Head still needs to finish to complete the picture Strong straight backline and nice shape to h/q. Moved out with good brisk stride, close up to 2.

1. **Massey's Ristine Tweedledee.**

1. **Smith's Ristine Black Sabbeth.** Cobby profile, presented in lovely harsh coat texture, pleasing head features. Good front assembly with straight front legs coming directly from chest. Firm straight topline into nicely shaped h/q. Moving out with typical brisk gait.
2. **Jones' Roopec Dinky Demon.** Smaller framed than 1 but cobby in shape and of correct proportions. Head of correct ratios and has a firm topline. His shoulder placement is quite good but has a habit, when standing, of putting his right pastern outwards. Moved quite well.

1. **Massey's Ristine Jack Black.** Presented in lovely harsh coat texture and he has beautiful body proportions A super head with good expression and well set ears. Straight front legs down to good feet. Straight firm topline and moved truly up and down . Close up.
2. **Mances' Mywulf Blue Sapphire.** Not quite the development of head as 1 but displays good body proportions. He has a straight front with good legs, strong neck, firm topline and decent loin. His coat is of very nice texture and he has brisk movement.
3. **Ristine Black Sabbeth.**

1. **Cheatham's Aradet Action Man Sh.cm.** This stunning 3yrs male just shouts " Schipperke", with his compact and square outline and presented in beautiful coat condition. Superb in head features and moving with positive brisk strides. Good reach and drive and true up and down. Must have his title. BD and BIS.
2. **Fludder's Aradet Xtra Addition.** Lovely head and well set ears. Good neck, firm topline. Has a good straight front and carries a dense coat. Moved round with brisk gait but moving a little close behind going away. RBD.
3. **Philpott's Ch. Aradet Expert Timing.** I see he is litter brother to 2. Has good head properties, neat ears and dark eye. Front assembly quite well put together. Moved out with purpose. A little longer than 1&2.

#### AOC OD (1)

1. **Ch. Chadbower Finlay for Blitzstan.** 2yrs cream, stood alone but a worthy winner. Strong with plenty of substance. Masculine head of good proportions, deep pigment, nice shoulder lay and deep brisket with good tuck up. Very alert and confident and moved out with brisk drive.

1. **Fludder's Aradet Shot in the Dark.** 10yrs and carrying his age wonderfully. Compact, short coupled, and good lay of shoulder ,firm topline. Has a pleasing head and eye. Presented in lovely coat and still moving soundly. BVIS
2. **Manner's Komargo's Crazy Diamond at Roopec.** 11yrs. Lacking a little substance and coat but still has some positive features. Typical masculine head with attractive well shaped dark eye, good neck and a very happy chap. Movement still quite true.

1. **Leah Scales.** Very competent performance. Good on the table, Carried out instructions at all times, moved her dog in correct positions with confidence.

#### MPB (1)

1. **Thorne's Aradet Dancing Queen for Schipdale.** At only 6mths very much a baby. Very attractive foreface, well set ears. Body of good proportions. Will need some schooling as she still thinks moving is a good playtime. I think she is very promising.

#### PB (3)

1. **Bugg's Komargo Fearless Florence.** A really promising prospect. Good balance to compact body. Well placed shoulders, deep brisket, good loin and right angulation to h/q. Very attractive head and dense coat. Moving with a lot of confidence for one so young. BPIS
2. **Hardy's Palmosa Angelique.** Nice conformation to this puppy. Foxy head, well shaped eye, firm topline and nice shape to quarters. Very enthusiastic type.
3. **Leaf's Skipon Golden Gemma.** Cream puppy with foxy feminine head features, well carried ears. Pigment quite good and she carries a firm topline well. Just going through that growing stage where the body needs to match the legs which makes the movement a little erratic.

1. **Thorne's Komargo Faithful Fiona at Schipdale.** Litter sister to BP. Nice type, Quality head, good neck, backline and well shaped hocks. Moved out steadily. Did not have quite the confidence of her sister.

1. **Wearing's Aradet Xotic Dancer.** Almost 6yrs but showing with such a lot of exuberance. Feminine head, I would have liked a little more strength to foreface, she has neat ears and a dark eye,. Firm backline but carrying a bit of weight over the loin and pinned in coming on. Good coat and a very happy girl.

1. **Rollinson's Chadblower islay Skye.** 18mths,compact, short coupled, has good angles in profile and stands on good feet. Attractive head features and presented in a lovely black dense coat. Sound in movement.

2. **Massey's Carazzo Black Lace at Ristine.** Lovely feminine head and expression. Straight front, legs correctly placed. Firm topline, good black coat texture. Moved out quite soundly.

3. **Millar's Abylity Nina's Celtic Queen of Turnlaw.** Slightly smaller type but displaying all the attributes . Totally balanced with cobby profile. Attractive feminine head with dark brown eye and well set ears. Moved out with positive brisk drive. Just wished there had been a little bit of her.

1. **Bugg's Ch. Byquy Black Carat.** Eye catching quality bitch with good coat colour and texture. Superb head features and expression. Strong compact body with firm straight back, strong loin and correct h/q with short hocks well let down. Moved with brisk drive and totally sound fore and aft. BB& RBIS.

2. **Fludder's Ch. & Am. Ch. Ebonorthnever on Sunday.** Well presented with good coat texture. Attractive headpiece on sturdy neck. Has very well placed shoulder and upper arm with straight front. Balanced totally throughout. Vety sound in movement and strides out positively.

1. **Skipon Golden Gemma.**

VB Un 10 yrs (2)

1. **Forknall's Ch. Avidore Hot Gossip.** 9yrs and full of beans. Attractive feminine head, oval eye, neat ears, strong neck and true cobby appearance. Straight front legs down to good feet. Coat of correct texture, moved out soundly and with such a lot of enthusiasm. Well handled.

2. **Manner's Scipsar Black Magic at Roopec.** 8yrs old, Head of moderate proportions, firm backline, Straight front, Moved out very well but not so outgoing as 1.

VB Ov 10yrs, (2)

1. **Wearing's Party Politics.** 11yrs going on about 3. So much enthusiasm. Cobby appearance, attractive head, well balanced throughout. Moving with spirit and really enjoying herself as was her handler.

2. **Whales' Ch. Qwontox Quidnung by Roshaana.** Slightly smaller framed 11yr old. Feminine sweet head, eye a little round, balanced cobby profile, firm backline, harsh coat, moved out well.
