CHAIRPERSON'S ANNUAL/AUTUMN REPORT

2019 has been a successful year for the Schipperke Club with both shows making a profit! Thanks must go to committee members, their family members and friends who have worked hard to enable the smooth running and success of the days. I would also like to say a very big thanks to our hardworking stewards at both shows and to you the exhibitors. I have commented at the last few shows about so few or no puppies being shown so I decided to look over the puppy registrations for the last few years. In 2015 36 were registered, 2016 - 47, 2017 - 29, 2018 - 33 and in 2019 up until the beginning of October 12! My first thoughts were that those numbers presented a somewhat bleak future, however on checking with the breed supplement I counted 16 puppies had been registered bringing the total for the year to 28. Not quite as high as in previous years but hopefully we will be seeing well attended puppy classes soon. These dogs will play an important role in the Schipperke's future.

A number of members over the past year have been concerned that the Kennel Club are apparently still displaying pictures of tailless Schips in up to date publications and as docking was banned on the 6th April 2007 why is this still occurring? Our Club Secretary, Melanie wrote to the KC in September and November last year, but to no avail. I contacted the KC in February this year to follow it up. It took several phone calls before I was put in touch with someone who had an understanding of the subject. The letters had never reached her! Very quickly she grasped the situation and asked for copies of the letters together with suitable pictures of tailed Schips, from which a composite could be made which she would then pass on to the Breed Council for their deliberation. As of the end of August we have not had a reply!

It seems such a long time since I wrote the first few paragraphs of my report, so I thought an update was in order.

At this time, I wish to mention the passing of Penny Fludder, who had been a member of the Schipperke Club for a number of years. She was a familiar face around the ring and a well known exhibitor and breeder together with her daughter Rachael. They had taken on the Aradet affix and had many successes in both the breed ring and stakes classes. She will be sadly missed by her many friends around the ring.

Recently Barbara West's husband Bill passed away. Barbara hasn't shown much recently but together they were regularly seen around the Schip ring.

You will be aware of the voting that took place at our much reduced online AGM, thank you to all who responded.

It has been an extremely difficult time for everyone and it is not over yet and who knows when that will be. I sincerely hope that you have all managed to stay fit and healthy, I must say that our dogs have got into such a routine that you would think they could tell the time as regards

walks and when they think it is meal time! We would have found lockdown quite a desperate time without them.

It has been a strange year without any shows and it looks as if it may continue that way for several months, with all General CH Shows being cancelled for the rest of the year. I feel that societies made the right decision to cancel shows before the Government made its decision. I for one look forward to staying safe and hopefully enjoying next year's shows.

I must say a very big thank you to our Club secretary Melanie who has worked tirelessly notifying all concerned about the cancellation of this year's shows and for organising everything for shows in 2021 including venues, judges and KC arrangements.

Stay safe all of you, I wish you all the best and look forward to seeing you at some point next year.

BREED HEALTH REPORT

I attended the Annual Health Seminar at Stoneleigh that focused on the work being carried out by the Animal Health Trust and the Kennel Club.

This research is being carried out on the breeds most vulnerable to genetic problems.

When I attend an event like this it makes me realise how lucky we are as a breed not to have major problems that occur in other breeds.

We are lucky to be able to offer £5 subsidy for any VWD (Von Willebrand's Disease) results reported to the Health Coordinator, this is funded by a grant received from the British Docked Breeds Council.

Please take advantage of this and get you dogs tested to enable their Club to gauge if this disease is a problem within our breed.

The Committee would like to remind members that and dog shown as a bobtail should show as a tested bobtail on their Kennel Club registration.

The ongoing discussions re MPSIIB have apparently now been resolved, my thanks to Ian Miller for dealing with this please see his report.

Please report any dogs that are clear by descent or clear by testing to me for inclusion on the register. Kennel Club advise is that dogs from clear stock should be tested every 3rd generation this will enable any rogue tests to be detected.



MPSIIIB

Most members will be aware that, although I stepped down as health coordinator some time ago, I have continued a dialogue with Dr Giger at the University of Pennsylvania for more than seven years now. In an attempt to help rebuild confidence in his test for MPSIIIB, I have pursued him on the question of publication of his data in a professional journal, a process which is preceded by scrutiny of the material by a panel of fellow scientists/geneticists to ensure that the basis of the test and the attendant procedures and protocols are sound and robust.

It has not always been easy to engage with Dr Giger and I have had to involve the Dean of the Veterinary Faculty, Dr Hoffman. I am delighted to report that the MPSIIIB test methodology and underpinning research information has now been peer-reviewed and published in February in “Natures Scientific Reports” a copy of which has been sent to me. I have forwarded copies to the Kennel Club, to Dr Jeff Sampson who was so helpful at various stages in this tortuous undertaking and to Dr Quillan, the veterinary surgeon who chairs the health committee of the Schipperke Club of America.

The document makes difficult reading given its dense genetic content but it is heartening to learn that the incidence of MPSIIIB in the breed is significantly reduced since the test was introduced. Well in excess of 3,000 dogs have been tested and the number of affected animals is now almost negligible while the number of carriers continues to reduce steadily. Breeders have been able to make informed decisions on proposed mating's given test results and overall, it appears that the breed is in a very much healthier position, world-wide, in relation to MPSIIIB than it was ten years ago.

The test is still available via Penngen but other facilities, primarily in the USA, are offering a test, virtually all based on the Penngen test. The kennel club now requires that third generation puppies born to parents who are clear of MPSIIIB by descent should be tested to ensure that there have been no further mutations in the genetic structure which is responsible for this dreadful disease.

Just for clarity, my involvement in this matter is now at an end!!

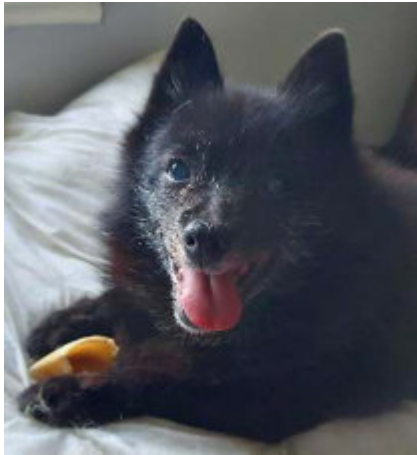

She wouldn't come into the house because she didn't trust the family member and was living in the garden. Following a Vet check all her teeth had to be removed but otherwise quite a fit lady for nearly 18 years old. It took some time but she settled into our household and became very attached to my husband. Consequently she is staying with us. She loves her food regardless of no teeth and can be a bit bossy with our other dogs who have quickly learned she's not to be trifled with.

These two 8 year old sisters recently needed rescuing because their owners dementia was causing welfare issues. Although well fed they were not put out to toilet as the owner wouldn't open any doors to either let people into the house or let the dogs out into the garden. After several weeks of this it was decided by the Mental Health Team, GPs and Police that a forced entry had to be made and the lady taken into care. The RSPCA should have taken the dogs into holding until I got to collect them but they didn't. So an



urgent trip had to be made with very little notice and with the help of Melanie and David Reed Peck we managed to get these girls into my car. As you can imagine this was a difficult task as they were traumatised and the house was in a terrible state. They have been with us now for a week at time of writing. They are coming round slowly, have had a bath and Vet check and although overweight are fit and healthy. As I knew about these girls last year I posted on the Club website and fb that if anyone was interested in giving these girls a home, enquiries would be welcome. There have been 2 and at the time of writing a potential new owner is coming to see them shortly. Hopefully they will be in their new home by the time you read this.

I would like to thank those who have made donations and offered help this year, your support is very important to enable Rescue to help our lovely breed when in need.

Schipperke Club Championship Show 19th October 2019

Firstly I would like to thank the Officers and Committee for their kind invitation to Judge and of course the exhibitors for their entries. It was a very enjoyable day with a good atmosphere a hard working Committee had provided a very good show which all present seemed to appreciate.

It was nice to hear applause for all winners, more shows should be like this. I had a student Judge with me all day, and this seemed to work very well and gave the opportunity for them to handle a reasonable number of animals so again well done to the Club for arranging this.

Though not a huge entry I was very pleased with my winners, a couple of concerns were soft coats and overall balance with some being in my view rather too long.

Puppy Dog (1)

1st Hall's CHADBLOWER DREW OF GHILGRANGE, rising 12 months very smart when stacked with good balance, good head properties nicely placed and used ears. Scored in front assembly with good top line and light quarters. Moved out nicely just needs to settle a little in front. Best Puppy Dog.

Junior Dog (3)

1st Mance's BLITZSTAN TELLER OF TAILS WITH RYEMAN, very promising youngster who has instant appeal, great body excellent ribbing nice angulation in front, good for bone and feet. Lovely expression with good pigmentation. Correct top line and well set tail just enough angulation in rear. He moves very well particularly going away, just a little unsettled in front so had to settle for RCC today. Must have a bright future.

2nd Finch's RISTINE STARRY NIGHT, scored in neck and shoulder here attractive head but would prefer a little more strength in muzzle. Body is well made with correct quarters, is a little long in loin but that said he moved well out and back.

Special Yearling Dog (1)

1st Holmes' ALL SET FOR DENCAS ALPHA NERO (IMP CZE), masculine outlook liked the eyes and ear placement which were well used, good pigmentation. Adequate bone and good feet though overall front good be a little tighter. Tail is a little flat very smart mover.

Post Graduate Dog (1)

1st Wearing's BLACKSHUCK BLUE SAPPHIRE WITH MIOFREY, very smart masculine dog needs to settle if he is to realise his potential as he has a lot to like. Very nice head and eye, good body and tuck up with a well made body. Moved well in front but a little close behind.

Limit Dog (6)

1st Forknall's AVIDORE PUTIN ON THE STYLE, Upstanding male, scored in front assembly here, well of for bone with good neck top line and body properties. Uses his ears well so lovely expression. Used himself well on the move both out and back.

2nd Thorne's SCHIPDALE REBUS, Overall better balance than winner, but ears are a little soft and not the front assembly body is deep and well made and moved out very briskly, looked good in profile.

3rdSmith's RISTINE BLACK SABBETH, Took time to settle here, but has lots to like again good overall balance good bone and correct light quarters. Attractive head nice set on of ears. Not quite as good on the move as remained a little unsettled.

Open Dog (4)

1st Collier's STONEYBURN BANNA, Needs to be handled as he is not overdone anywhere, excellent balance to head lovely eyes providing for correct expression. Well made body good tuck up and ribbing light quarters used to advantage in the move which was brisk and positive.

2ndBrooks' FANDALS VILJAM AT RIDGEBROOK (FIN IMP), A little heavier made right through, he has a deep well made body with good bone and feet. Top line could be a little firmer and coat is a tad soft. He moves well out and back.

3rdRollingson's FIN/IR CH/ FANDALS UN AMOR FOR CHADBLOWER, Scored for size and balance in terms of body properties, but would prefer tighter front and slightly stronger rear, that said he moved very soundly out and back.

AOC Open Dog (1)

1st Moore & Nock's CH CHADBOWER FINLAY FOR BLITZSTAN, Very good overall balanced cream liked his head and expression excellent pigmentation, has a deep well made body with good tuck up. Smart mover maintains his top line and outline, being hypercritical would prefer a little more bone.

Champion Dog (4)

1st Plourde, O'Brien & McLachlan's CR CH AMCH WHISPERING PINES COVERT OP, Beautiful male at top of his form well made body excellent head eye and expression, correct ears which are well used. Scores for bone and feet well laid shoulders with enough neck. Good top line and tail set, harsh coat. Smart brisk mover particularly good in profile. CC and Best Opposite Sex seemed to have something on his mind later in the day suspect he got wind of a bitch in season hence completely unsettled.

2ndWilson's CH/ IR CH CHADBLOWER NEVAN HENKI MIT CLYNAWLIN NW IR JCH, BEL JCH, Out of a smaller mould and a little out of coat today, very well made overall, liked his head balance and use of ears. Deep body with good tuck up, well set tail. moved well from strong light quarters.

3rdMance's CH RYEMAN ROBIN, Slight longer than those above but overall well balanced, scores in neck and shoulders firm well made body with good ribbing. good mover which is brisk with enough reach and drive.

Veteran Dog Under 10 (1)

1st Philpott's CH ARADET EXPERT TIMING, Very smart 8 year old, dense black excellent pigmentation, lovely head and expression, good bone and feet very well put together body, deep and good tuck up. Correct quarters used well on the move. Best Veteran in Show.

Veteran Dog Over 10 (1)

1st Manners' KOMARGOS CRAZY DIAMOND AT ROOSEVELT, 13 year old and full of himself, still retains a lovely outline and dark expressive eyes, body is in good condition and has a firm top line. When he settled he can still show some of the youngsters how to move.

Good Citizen Dog (1)

1st Philpott's CH ARADET EXPERT TIMING

Puppy Bitch (3)

Nice class

1st Millard's OSO DEL MIEL LA BOMBA TO ARADET (IMP RUS), More together and forward than the others here, appears a tad long but on handling isn't she has good balance to head and body. Excellent bone and feet very good quarters, looks great when stacked and doesn't disappoint on the move, has a bright future.

2nd McKenna & Forknall's TREDREAS SCOTIA PRINCESS AMONG AVIDORE, Scared for bone and shoulder here, well set on neck deep well made body firm top line maintained on the move. Between coats but nothing to hide.

3rd Rollingson's CHADBOWER EMILIA, Still rather raw at the moment ultra feminine with all, the desired qualities for age and development just needs time to come together in body. Smart mover.

Junior Bitch (2)

1st McLachlan's FULLMOON SOME LIKE IT HOT (IMP USA), Still a Puppy and a real glamour girl, beautiful head and expression well placed and used ears. Has a deep well made body with good ribbing and tuck up. Correct top line and light though strong hindquarters. She moves well particularly out and back, to be hypercritical I would like just a little more leg, but undoubtedly a quality butch with a bright future. RCC, Reserve Best in Show and Best Puppy.

2nd Philpott's KOMARGO GOING FOR GOLD, A little bigger all over but still retains femininity, excellent pigmentation for colour. Was a little unsettled both handling and on the move which made assessment a little difficult certainly worth persevering as she has promise.

Limit Bitch (4)

1st Manners' CHADBOWER NEVAEH LAHETTI, Needs to be handled to appreciate her many qualities she is so very typical. Not overdone in any way, lovely head and expo very good pigmentation. First rate bone and feet, great neck and shoulders strong well made body good ribbing and tuck up. Harsh coat of good texture, correct brisk mover both ways and looks good in profile. A very honest typical Schipp CC and BIS, I understand her second so well done.

2nd Reed's STONEYBURN ARBEIA, In. Any way not dissimilar to winner, though a little lighter in eye, she also is well made in terms of body properties, has excellent quarters and is a smart and positive mover.

3rd Paterson's TURNLAW SWEET NOTHINGS, Appeared a little raw and unsettled here, that said she moves extremely well out and back and overall is very well balanced.

Open Bitch (4)

1st McKenna & Forknall's CH ARADET BLACK ORCHID, Scored in eyes and expression here, she is well made overall and uses herself to advantage on the move. She has the desired light quarters and a very good quality coat texture.

2nd Rollingson's CHADBOWER ISLAS SKYE, A little light in eye and for me slightly overangulate in rear quarters. She is however well balanced and good on the move.

Open Bitch AOC (2)

1st Brooks' RISTINE GOLD PANDORA, Rather unsettled on handling and on the move she got much better the longer she was in the ring and is worth persevering with unfair to comment, but she showed enough breed type to win here.

Champion Bitch (3)

1st McLachlan & Penatello's CH CRCH NED LUX IT AM CH BEACHVIEWS OOPE I DID IT AGAIN, Glamour girl lovely head and eye good shoulders with enough bone and good feet, strong well made body and used herself well out and back. looks good in profile.

2nd Hardy's CH PALMOSA ANGELIQUE, Not the expression of winner though head has good balance, clean through the shoulder and strong neck and body properties ok on the move though a little sluggish.

Veteran Bitch Under 10 (5)

1st As above

2nd Fludder's AMCH/ CH EBONORTH NEVER ON A SUNDAY, Lovely size and balance good head properties and expression. Scored in front with good body properties moved ok in front but lacked drive going away.

3rd Massey's SCHIAPSAR ALICE IN WONDERLAND AT RISTINE, Size larger and not quite as feminine in overall outlook, good overall balance and when she settled gave a good account of herself out and back.

Veteran Bitch Over 10 (1)

1st Forknall's CH AVIDORE HOT GOSSIP, Very well made a little full in the eye but that said has a nice expression, body is still well made and she can still move out to advantage. Best Veteran Bitch.

Good Citizen Bitch (1)

1st Reed's STONEYBURN MAIA, Very stylish, lovely head and expression good use of ears, excellent pigmentation good front bone and feet deep body used well on the move a very nice bitch. Don't think she will be eligible for this class for too long.

Best Junior Handler was Charlotte Wilson a very competent sympathetic handler who got the best out of her exhibit in an unhurried unflustered way.

Thank you to those who put their Schipperkes under me today, giving me some tough decisions, and for the sporting way you accepted my placings. I really enjoyed my day with you.

Special Yearling Dog or Bitch (4,1a)

1st **Millard's OSO DE MIEL LA BOMBA TO ARADET (IMP RUS)**. 11 month black bitch. Lovely feminine head with erect ears set well. Dark eyes giving typical expression. Correct scissor bite. Slight arch to neck leading to slightly sloping shoulders and straight back. Good angles fore and aft. Harsh coat with good culottes and mane developing. Moved briskly, with purpose, which won her the class.

2nd **Philpott's KOMARGO GOING FOR GOLD**. Attractive 13 month gold bitch of good type. Dark eye, good mouth with scissor bite. Well set erect ears used to advantage. Good pigment. Slight arch to neck, good shoulders and straight back. Good turn of stifle, not over angulated. Harsh coat with culottes and mane developing and well carried tail. Moved well.

3rd **Finch's RISTINE STARRY NIGHT**. 12 month black dog. Also good for type. Cracking masculine head with good pigment, dark eye, correct mouth and good ear set. Slightly arched neck leading to good shoulders and well made body. Liked his harsh jacket and well curled tail. Moved well. A little apprehensive on the table today which cost him the class. I would like to see him again once he has gained his confidence, which I'm sure will come with time.

Special Limit Dog or Bitch (5,1a)

1st **Reed's STONEYBURN ARBEIA**. 3yr black bitch of lovely size and type. I liked her as soon as she came into the ring and she didn't disappoint on closer examination. Feminine head with dark expressive eyes. Erect ears used to advantage. Slightly arched neck leading to good shoulders and level back. Well placed front legs, well under body. Well angled rear with short hocks. Correct coat, harsh, with well curled tail. Beautifully presented. She moved well with a brisk action. My notes say 'a happy dog!' Had a lovely outline which won her the class eventually.

2nd **Manners' CHADBOWER NEVAEH LAHETTI**. 2yr black bitch. Slightly larger than 1st but still a good type. Feminine foxy head with correct properties. Well made front and rear, straight back with well curled tail carried correctly on the move. Good coat with correct culottes and mane. Moved briskly. Pushed hard for 1st place.

3rd **Thorne's SCHIPDALE REBUS**. 2yr black dog. Slightly bigger masculine boy, slightly longer cast than the previous two Schips, but still of good quality. I liked his head with good dark eyes and erect ears which he used to advantage. Correct scissor bite. Slight arch to neck leading to good chunky body with straight back. Harsh masculine jacket, good culottes and well curled tail. Well muscled, which reflected in his correct movement. Just lacked the sparkle to take the class today. I'm sure on another day these positions could change.

Special Open Dog or Bitch (10,2a)

A really lovely class, I was spoilt for choice and really had to 'nit pick' between my winners.

1st **Rollinson's FIN/IR CH FANDAL'S UN AMOR FOR CHADBOWER**. 5yr black dog. No surprise to find this beautifully presented boy is titled. Superb masculine head with dark, sparkling eyes, erect well placed ears used to advantage. Great pigment, and correct scissor bite. Slight arch to neck, cobby body with straight back. Good forechest and a broad, deep chest, forelegs well under body and muscular hindquarters. Harsh, dense jacket with well set and curled tail. Moved briskly and with purpose. He was 'all male' and to me he screamed quality.

2nd **Smith's RISTINE BLACK SABBETH**. 4yr black dog. So similar in make and type to 1st, many similar comments apply. A lovely, mature male with a masculine head with good properties, well made cobby body. I liked his make and shape a lot, he just lost out to the overall demeanour of 1st

3rd **Wilson's CH/IR CH CHADBOWER NEVAN HENKI MIT CLYNALWIN**. 2yr black dog. Another super quality Schipperke, full of breed type and required points. I particularly liked his head with it's great pigment, expressive eyes and correct bite. As with 1 & 2 he moved briskly and with purpose. Fabulous coat and culottes and also presented in tip top form.

This award is designed to encourage Schipperke owners to take part in other sports and gain points for all level of achievements. The presentation will take place at the Annual General Meeting each year.

Closing date for applications is 30th January each year.

Platinum	Achieved by gaining 12 points over 3 or more disciplines
Gold	Achieved by gaining 9 points over 3 or more disciplines
Silver	Achieved by gaining 6 points over 2 or more disciplines
Bronze	Achieved by gaining 3 points over 2 or more disciplines

Rules:

- ❖ Only the owner of the dog can claim for points (parent of children under 16 years old need to apply on their behalf). The award is dog based.
- ❖ Sports/disciplines not covered in the points table may be eligible for inclusion.

Instructions for claims

- ❖ Claims must be made on the appropriate form (from the Schipperke Club website) and be current members of active dogs.
- ❖ Only one score is allowed for each discipline.
- ❖ Once the level is awarded, further disciplines will be needed, to progress to the next level.
- ❖ All claims must be accompanied by documentary evidence. Please submit your points of award to include level of achievement within the sport, making it as clear as possible. Photocopies are acceptable as are photographs of rosettes.
- ❖ The club's decision is final in all disputes.
- ❖ The Criteria for this award will be on the club website

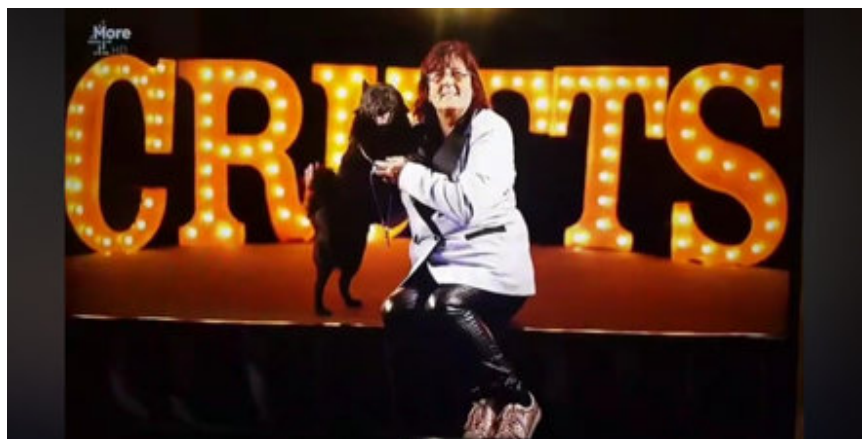
